MUCH LIKE PLM, **ISOP** IS AN ORGANIZATION STEEPED IN HISTORY

A leading association within the insurance industry, the Insurance Society of Philadelphia (ISOP) has been dedicated to serving insurance professionals for 117 years. ISOP was founded in 1901 to provide a common ground for risk and insurance professionals to share the latest industry developments, network and join together to support its communities. (Just a few years earlier, in 1895, the Pennsylvania Lumbermens Mutual Fire Insurance Company was founded—today, we're known as Pennsylvania Lumbermens Mutual).

ISOP was founded as the Fire Insurance Society of Philadelphia. The organization was designed to support fire insurance companies and community members. In 1909, it expanded to other insurance specialties. By 1925, it had rebranded to the Insurance Society of Philadelphia. For 117 years, ISOP has played a pivotal role in the risk and insurance community in the Delaware Valley.

Today, ISOP serves the community in a number of ways. It provides career development resources in the form of a symposium series and workshop opportunities. ISOP also hosts networking opportunities where members can meet and learn from their fellow experts.

ISOP is also dedicated to serving the next generation of insurance professionals, which it does through its NextGen group. NextGen provides resources including, education, professional development, mentorships, networking and community and volunteer opportunities. Additionally, ISOP provides a scholarship program where the organization has awarded more than \$300,000 to students since the program's creation in 2001.

ISOP has become known for its ongoing work with the Philadelphia Fire Department and the Philadelphia Fire Department Foundation. It has partnered with the Insurance Industry Charitable Foundation (IICF) and several universities, including Drexel University, Lasalle University and Saint Joseph's University, to support risk management education. FUNDRAISING FOR SMOKE DETECTORS AHEAD OF GALA

The Independence Gala hosted by ISOP is not only an opportunity for industry experts to congregate and network, but also a key charity event. Every year, ISOP partners with the Philadelphia Fire Department Foundation, a non-profit dedicated to preventing fires and promoting safety. The Foundation regularly supplies 10-year lithium battery smoke detectors to Philadelphia homes in need. As part of the partnership, ISOP raises funds for the detectors through a text-to-pledge campaign during the Independence Gala. The fundraiser supports the Foundation's continuing endeavors to keep the Philadelphia community fire safe.

ISOP started this fundraising effort in 2012, when former Philadelphia Mayor Michael Nutter requested help in reducing the city's fire risk. They held their first fundraiser at that year's Independence Gala, and since then, have held one every year at the event. In addition, ISOP members go door-to-door with the Fire Department to help install the detectors annually in October during the Insurance Industry Charitable Foundation's Annual Week of Giving. Since the program's inception, ISOP has raised more than \$250,000.

At this year's Independence Gala, ISOP will again be hosting their text-to-pledge fundraiser. To help support the Philadelphia Fire Department Foundation, as well as the Philadelphia community, we are asking our associates, customers and brokers to consider pledging to donate before the event. Pledges will be collected on our site, www.plmins.com/gala. The total pledges of PLM supporters will be presented at the Gala. Please join us in our ambitious goal to exceed last year's total pledge of a little over \$45,000.00 towards fire prevention in the Philadelphia area.
